

## **The Chess Trust – Application for a Grant**

**Applications need to be made in reasonable time to be considered by the Trustees. The Trust normally considers applications for grants in March and September each year. The dates of the meetings which will consider grants will be published on the Trust’s website and the ECF’s website with the final dates for submitting applications.**

**Applicants need to consider the objectives of the Trust and how their application will align with those objectives.**

**The Trust’s objectives are:**

- (1) The advancement of amateur sport by promoting the study and practice of chess in all its forms, principally, but not exclusively, for the benefit of the residents of England; and
- (2) The advancement of education by promoting the development of young people through the teaching and practice of chess.
